



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Trade Essentials® Cabinet Backing Board quality laminated panels are versatile pre-decorated panels with a durable melamine surface. For interior use only, Trade Essentials® Cabinet Backing Board is available in a range of sizes and thicknesses. Please refer to laminex.co.nz for Trade Essentials® Cabinet Backing Board availability.

Never use any of the following abrasive cleaners: Jif, Ajax, Chemico, Brasso, oven cleaners, neat Janola, wire wool, scourer pads, sandpaper.

CLEANING

- A soft cloth should always be used, apply cleaning products to the cloth rather than directly onto the product.
- Wash down with warm water with a small amount of

detergent. For best results use streak free glass cleaner with a soft cloth.

SPILLAGES

- Hair rinse, Janola (neat) Harpic, oven cleaners – wash with hot soapy water, then wipe dry.
- Fabric dye – wash with cold water, then wipe dry. Then apply methylated spirits and wipe dry.
- Battery acid, hydrogen peroxide, glue hardeners – wash with cold water then wipe dry.
- Hair dye – wash with methylated spirits then wipe dry.
- Leather dye – wash with methylated spirits then wipe dry. Follow with mineral turpentine, wash and wipe dry.

STAIN AND MARK REMOVAL

- Stubborn marks or stains – apply Handy Andy or diluted Janola (one part to three parts water), then wipe down with a warm damp cloth.

- Smearing, finger marks, marking from cold or hot dishes, stickiness – apply one or two applications of acetone (available at pharmacies) and wipe over with a dry cloth.
- Newsprint – use methylated spirits or mineral turpentine
- Rust – use vinegar or lemon juice
- Pencil – use water and a damp cloth
- Felt pen or dry marker – use methylated spirits or acetone
- Paint – use acetone or Duco Lacquer thinners (from a paint shop)
- Glue – contact type – use Ados Solvent N (from a paint shop)

Once again with any of the above use streak free glass cleaner to remove any residues.
